IPC Powerlifting will announce its decision to approve the competition officially in writing.					
The application must be submitted with a 100€ fee on the IPC account (see application).					
All approved competitions will appear in the IPC Powerlifting calendar immediately upon approval.					
AREA	MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS				
Endorsement	Where the competition is organized by an LOC other than the NPC the application must still be acknowledged and endorsed by the respective NPC and the respective field in this application must be completed.				
Rules	The competition must always be held according to current IPC PO Rules.				
Entries	For an event to be viable for medals the minimum number of athletes per weight category must be 3 . In case of a category with less than 3 athletes then it will be considered non-viable and weight categories will be grouped together. The HAL formula should be used for such combined categories as per the IPC PO rules.				
	The final entries list must be sent to IPC PO the day after the published final entries deadline and no later than 6 weeks and no earlier than 8 weeks prior the start of the competition. The athlete's international classification status (if available) must be included in the entry list.				
Technical Officials	The competition must be conducted by appointed International and National IPC PO referees, as directed by/agreed with IPC PO.

Applications submitted outside the given timelines or are not completed in full will not be accepted.	
IPC Powerlifting will announce its decision to approve the competition officially in writing.	
The application must be submitted with a 50€ fee on the IPC account (see application).	
All approved competitions will appear in the IPC Powerlifting calendar immediately upon approval.	
AREA	MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS
Endorsement	Where the competition is organized by an LOC other than the NPC the application must still be acknowledged and endorsed by the respective NPC and the respective field in this application must be completed.
Rules	The competition must always be held according to current IPC PO Rules.
Entries	Athletes without an IPC license can compete in this competition yet must be licensed to have results entered onto the ranking list and for recognition of any records.
	The maximum number of participating countries in National competitions is the organizing country and up to a maximum of 3 individuals from other nations. Where this condition is not adhered to, then only results from the Host Nations athletes will be taken into consideration for ranking purposes.
	The minimum number of athletes for a weight category to be viable on its own is 3 . Where numbers per weight category are lower than 3 then categories must be combined and the HAL formula should be applied. Where this becomes necessary and is practically possible the AH formula and groups should be used as per the IPC Powerlifting rules.
	The final entries list must be sent to IPC PO the day after the published final entries deadline and no later than 2 weeks prior the start of the competition. The athlete's international classification status (if available) must be included in the entry list.
Technical Officials	Only referees currently recognised / licensed by IPC PO can officiate at the competition otherwise the results will be deemed invalid.
	The list of officials submitted by the LOC is subject to IPC PO final approval.
Classification	It is not mandatory for athletes entering National Competitions to have international classification.
Results	Only results of athletes who are licensed by IPC PO within the given timelines for results recognition and have an "R" or "C" sport class status will be taken into consideration for inclusion in the official World and Regional ranking lists.
	The LOC should submit the results of this competition to IPC PO on the electronic version supplied by IPC PO immediately after the end of the competition.
Records	World record applications will <u>only be accepted</u> where IPC approved Doping Control is conducted on the athlete.
	Only results of athletes who are licensed by IPC PO within the given timelines for results recognition and have an "R" or "C" sport class status will be taken into consideration for inclusion in the official World and Regional record lists.
	All World and Regional record applications submitted must be as per the process and rules laid down in the IPC Powerlifting Rulebook.
Doping Control	<u>Must be conducted</u> under National jurisdiction.
