9. Powerlifters Eligibility

To be eligible for selection by an NPC for the 2010 IPC Powerlifting World Championships powerlifters must:

- hold an active IPC Powerlifting License for the 2010 season;
- have achieved a Minimum Qualification Standard (MQS) at an IPC Powerlifting recognized competition for the respective event between the 1 January 2009 and 11 June 2010 with the exception on the case that is described on rule 17.3 “a country is allowed to participate with a maximum of one (1) lifter who has not met the qualifying standards if they have less than three (3) lifters in the competition”;
- have a “New” (N), “Review” (R) or “Confirmed” (C) sport class status before 11 June 2010.

11. Competition Rules

The competition rules shall be in accordance with the IPC Powerlifting Rulebook 2004 - 2008.

12. Maximum Nr. of Entries per NPC per Bodyweight category

Each invited NPC may enter athletes as described in the IPC Powerlifting Rules Art. 5 (5.1, 5.2.1, 5.2.2, 5.3, 5.3.1 and 5.3.2) as follows :

- 5.1. Men and women's competition in each bodyweight category.
- 5.2.1 At Paralympic Games, World Championships, Continental Championships and Games each nation is allowed, per Disability Group, a maximum of 10 competitors spread throughout the range of the 10-bodyweight categories for men and 10 competitors throughout the range of the 10-bodyweight categories for women. There must not be more than 3 competitors from any one nation in any particular bodyweight category with a maximum of 2 per disability group. **For example:** 2 spinal cord injured + 1 amputee or 1 spinal cord injured + 2 amputees or 2 amputees + 1 cp, etc.

- 5.2.2. At World and Continental Championships each nation is allowed a maximum of **10 Junior** competitors spread throughout the range of the 10 bodyweight categories for **men** and **10 Junior** competitors throughout the range of the 10 bodyweight categories for **women**. There must not be more than 2 competitors from any nation in any particular bodyweight category.
- 5.3. The competitors become eligible to compete in this sport the day of their **14th birthday**.
- 5.3.1. Men-Women Open from the day he reaches 14 years and upwards (no category restrictions need apply).
- 5.3.2. Men-Women Junior from the day he reaches 14 years and upwards to his birthday of 23 years.

13. Regulations

Competition Format

The 2010 IPC Powerlifting World Championships will be conducted in single body weight categories competition format. For body weight categories that do not meet the Event Viability Criteria (minimum of three (3) eligible powerlifters) the HAL formula will be used.

Maximum Entry per NPC

HAL formula will apply should the numbers of athletes in each bodyweight category is less than three (3).

NPCs can enter a maximum of ten (10) male eligible powerlifters and ten (10) female eligible powerlifters in the range of the 20 body weight categories for men and women. Furthermore there must not be more than three (3) eligible powerlifters per category per NPC with a maximum of 2 per disability group.

NPCs can enter a maximum of ten (10) junior male eligible powerlifters and ten (10) junior female eligible powerlifters in the range of the 20 body weight categories for men and women. Further more there must not be more than two (2) eligible junior powerlifter per category per NPC.

14. International Classification

International Classification will take place on the 24 July 2010 at the official hotel. The classification schedule will be announced after the deadline of the final entries.

REMARK

For classified athletes owning an IPC Powerlifting Passport or photocopy of the Classification Forms are to bring their IPC Powerlifting Forms to the competition during registration.

15. Competition Fee

The competition fee for the 2010 IPC Powerlifting World Championships, Kuala Lumpur is 550 EUR.

The competition fee covers all the Championships services including meals (lunch and dinner), transport (to/from airport, official Championships hotels to venues) and other competition management from the 23 July – 1 August 2010.

The competition fee is to be paid to IPC Powerlifting by **14 May 2010** accordance to the invoice that will be sent by IPC Powerlifting to each NPC following the Entry by deadline.

Following 14 May 2010 there will be no reimbursement for any team members withdrawn.

16. Accommodation Fee.

The LOC will make accommodation arrangements for all invited NPC delegations entering the competition.

The charges for accommodation will depend on the hotel that NPC Delegation decided to stay. The LOC will provide information on the hotel by **15 February 2010.**

17. Entry Form deadlines

- f) Visa Request Form (Form I) - **Deadline : 11 June 2010**

Note :

- i) All athletes participating in each category is to be finalized in the Final Entry Forms. Changes is allowed only during the Technical Meeting with the penalty €100.
- ii) All Entry Forms are to be submitted through their respective NPCs.

18. Visa Arrangements and Immigration

For those delegation members who require visa to enter Malaysia, you are to contact the nearest Malaysian Embassy in your country. All NPC's to fill up the Visa Request Form and sent it to the OC. The OC will provide you with a formal invitation letter together with the list of your delegation to your NPC and the Malaysian Embassy in your country.

Please be reminded that it is important that your NPC arrange all RELEVANT VISAS well in advance with the respective deadlines.

19. Yellow Fever

A Yellow Fever vaccination required from all Malaysian going to/through Yellow Fever Endemic areas/countries and visitors coming from/through Yellow Fever Endemic areas/countries. The vaccination certificate is only valid if the vaccine is approved by WHO and administered at an approved Yellow Fever Vaccinating Centre.

In accordance with article 68 of the International Health Regulations of the WHO, travelers without a valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate shall be quarantined upon arrival in Malaysia. **(Please refer to attachment)**

20. Transportation

Air travel

The OC will provide transportation at no cost to registered NPC delegations to and from Kuala Lumpur International Airport to the Hotel for delegations arriving by airplane.

Delegations are kindly requested to book flights with final destination Kuala Lumpur.

Ground Transportation during the Competition

OC will provide transportation to and from the designated hotel to the competition and training venue.

21. Accreditation

Athletes and NPC Team Officials must provide the **ACCREDITATION FORM** with two (2) passport photo's (4.5cm x 3.5cm) for their Accreditation Card.

22. Insurance

Each NPC must ensure that all members of their delegation are appropriately insured, including but not limited to coverage for travel, liability and accidents.

23. Doping Control

Doping Control will be conducted under the IPC Anti-Doping Code.

24. Medals

Senior Events

Where numbers are sufficient medals will be awarded to the top three (3) ranked athletes in the Championships per weight category for Men and Women Seniors.

When the numbers are low – less than three (3) – the HAL formula will apply and medals will be awarded accordingly.

Junior Events

Where numbers are sufficient medals will be awarded to the top three (3) ranked athletes in the Championships per weight category for Men and Women Juniors.

When the numbers are low – less than three (3) – medals will be awarded following the “minus one rule”. In case there only one (1) athlete in the category then the athlete must have to achieved the World Championships MQS to receive medals otherwise they will be awarded o diploma only.
